「The 10th Joint Symposium of Veterinary Research among Universities of Veterinary Medicine in East Asia」



The 10th Joint Symposium of Veterinary Research among Universities of Veterinary Medicine in East Asia was held on Gifu Univ. campus from February 18 to 19, 2019.

Associate Professor Shinya Fukumoto from the United Graduate School of Veterinary Sciences (UGSVS) delivered a keynote speech, which was followed by poster presentations by five UGSVS students and oral presentations by

three students. Of them, Ms. Appiah-Kwarteng Cornelia was presented an outstanding performance award for her work. Ninety people took part in this two-day symposium from ten universities in Asia (Taiwan, South Korea, Hong Kong and Indonesia) including Japan. Young researchers enjoyed the moment of associating with veterinary researchers and scholars from Asia.

The 10th Joint Symposium marked the end of this kind of international conference, and a new form of academic gathering will start from academic year 2019.
